Our Going Medical Banquet has come and gone. Our medical transition is beginning, and we will be undergoing much change within the next year. We will have limited ultrasounds available within the year and more abortion-determined clients walking through our doors as a result of this.

If we stop and think about all the changes that will be taking place, it is easy to consider sticking to what we have been doing the past 27 years. What we have been doing is comfortable. We know what to do, and we do it well. We know what to expect, how much it will cost, and who will be the one doing each task. Now to change it all to go into uncertainty?

We are stepping out into faith trusting that God will give us the wisdom to do all things in excellence with this transition. We trust God is faithful to bring the finances to provide limited ultrasounds and the increased expense of using more electricity, heat, and a wing of our building that hasn't been used for some time. We are trusting that He brings the perfect Nurse Manager or sonographer to oversee the medical policies and staffing of medical volunteers.

At times, I can begin to get a little overwhelmed with the thought of all of this! However, God hasn't called us to a life of comfortability and mediocrity. He has called us to "get out of the boat" and take a step of faith. I love the quote from Martin Luther King Jr. that states, "Faith is taking the first step even when you don't see the whole staircase."

When the questions of the "what if's" begin to arise within my heart, I take comfort in knowing that this isn't our or my ministry. This is God's ministry. He loves our clients and our work more than we do. He is in control. I find comfort in His word when I may begin to fear what obstacles the future may hold with such a transition.
