What if the CHURCH WEPT over abortion?

"Weeping is one of the deepest expressions of emotion ... 'Jesus Wept' is a verse that reminds us that God deeply loves us."

Abortion is a spiritual issue. It is a direct attack on the image of God. This matters to him. At Abigail Pregnancy Services we consider ourselves the church, as in the body of believers. Every year we observe the Sanctity of Human Life Sunday in the month of January as it was decreed on January 13, 1984. President Ronald Reagan issued a proclamation designating January 22 as the first National Sanctity of Human Life Day. (January 22, 1973, was the day the U.S. Supreme Court legalized abortion-on-demand in all 50 states.) Churches around the United States use the day to celebrate God's gift of life. commemorate the many lives lost to abortion, and commit themselves to protecting human life at every stage.

What Does This Mean To Us?

The work that we do day in and day out is an act of worship and a celebration of the sanctity of human life. Giving our clients options other than abortion, with practical and spiritual support, filtered through the lens of the Gospel is our focus. Helping clients to see for themselves that their lives are precious in the sight of God and in turn their children's lives are too.

The heart of Jesus is the heart of this ministry: to glorify God and to demonstrate His character. It is a privilege and a call that we do not take lightly.

What Does This Mean To You?

We invite you to prayerfully consider what the issue of abortion truly means to you. Are you willing to act on your convictions? It is only when we stand together in love that hearts will be changed and eyes will be opened to this senseless loss of life that grieves God so deeply. Please join us as we pray for an end to abortion and ask God how He would have you join in the fight for life.

Speaking Life to the Next Generation

Recently Abigail had the privilege to speak about the Sanctity of Human Life to the students at Trinity Christian Academy.

The students were given a bottle of bubbles and asked a question about the bubbles they blew: "what is inside the bubbles?" As expected they all said "Air!" That was the perfect opportunity to tell them it was BREATH, and that God created us by breathing life into us! We talked about how, like the bubbles, human life is fragile and must be protected. It was amazing to see these children respond to this object lesson! The students are also participating in a Baby Bottle Campaign to raise funds for the ministry. We are grateful for their efforts!



We are also very excited that we have 3 local schools scheduled for our Sexual Integrity Program so far this year. This program, geared towards teaching kids about self worth, abstinence, and healthy relationships, (among other subjects) is an important part of our ministry.
