Every day as peer counselors at Abigail we have the privilege of meeting with struggling moms to encourage them in their motherhood journey. Often times we are the ones most blessed and challenged by the courageous clients that God ushers into our counseling rooms; such a client is our dear friend, Shannon. We first met Shannon a couple years ago when her son, Zachary, was four months old. Shannon was going through a difficult time. Not only was she experiencing debilitating post-partum depression, but she and her husband were struggling financially. Shannon finally broke down and reached out to local agencies for help. From the moment Shannon stepped into Abigail's she felt a tremendous bond with our staff. After her first counseling session, Shannon began seeking the Lord and got connected to a local church. It has been an honor for us to watch this beautiful young mom grow in her faith.

This summer Shannon experienced a devastating blow when her mother, her best friend, died after a brief battle with cancer. Her mom's death shook Shannon's faith, but she continued to seek material, emotional, and spiritual support from her "Abigail Ladies". Over the past several months each of us has ministered to our sweet friend through prayers, tears, and our personal stories of loss. Thankfully things are getting better for Shannon. In January she and her husband were blessed with their second son, Anikin. In addition, Shannon has slowly begun to connect with her Heavenly Father. Each time we see her we notice that she is becoming stronger both emotionally and spiritually. Please continue to pray for Shannon and her beautiful family.

In closing, we want to leave you with some words Shannon penned to our staff: *"I have been given these trials to find out how strong I am, and I felt so weak, but you helped me take that step to walk into church and pray to God. I am just still trying to figure out that plan! But because of you at Abigail's I have been brought closer to God and you have helped me believe in the good of people! Thank you so much for all you do for new moms and pregnant moms. I love what you do and I am so glad there is a place like this for women to go to for religion and help with pregnancy and motherhood!"*
