## Beyond The Basics Success

There are so many new and exciting changes going on at Abigail Pregnancy Services, one of them being our revamped parenting program, "Beyond Basics", which educates parents of toddler-aged children. Just this week, we celebrated our first graduate of the program.

Savannah was an addict who had been clean for two years, but in a moment of weakness, this past November, she used and overdosed. As a result, her two year old daughter was placed in foster care, and Savannah entered into a rehabilitation facility. Upon being released from rehab last month, Savannah's main focus was to regain custody of her daughter. Her case worker referred her to Abigail's parenting program. Even though parenting classes were not court mandated, Savannah felt that this was a good first step in getting her daughter back.

In the brief time that we've worked with Savannah, we've seen this determined young lady successfully achieve a multitude of accomplishments including: finding a place to live, getting a job, receiving professional counseling, earning unsupervised visits with her daughter, and completing our "Beyond the Basics" parenting program.

Savannah admitted that when she first came to Abigail she was very nervous. However, she found the staff to be extremely welcoming and was immediately put at ease. Savannah faithfully attended our parenting classes, which she described as being very informative, two times a week enabling her to finish the six class program within a month. Upon fulfilling the requirements of "Beyond the Basics", she received a certificate, an official letter of completion for the courts, and a graduation gift---a toddler bed, which Savannah hopes her daughter will be sleeping in this fall. Most importantly, however, she has gained a new confidence for the future equipped with the needed skills to help her become the best mom she can be. In Savannah's own words, "The past is the past", and she is more determined than ever to be legally united with her daughter.
